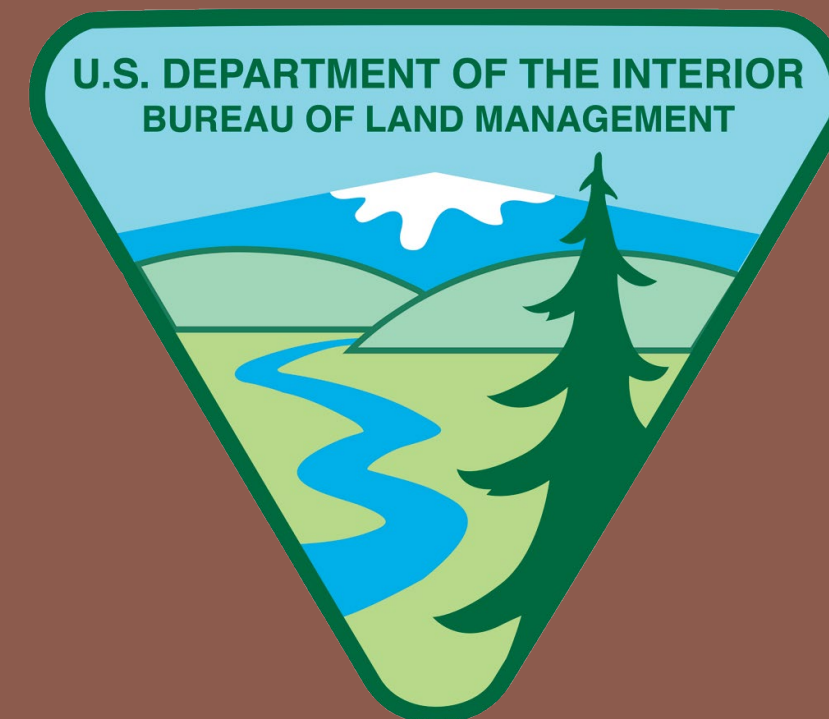

Paleoindian Period: 11,000–7000 B.C.

Clovis, Folsom, Midland, Plainview, Milnesand, Agate Basin, and Cody



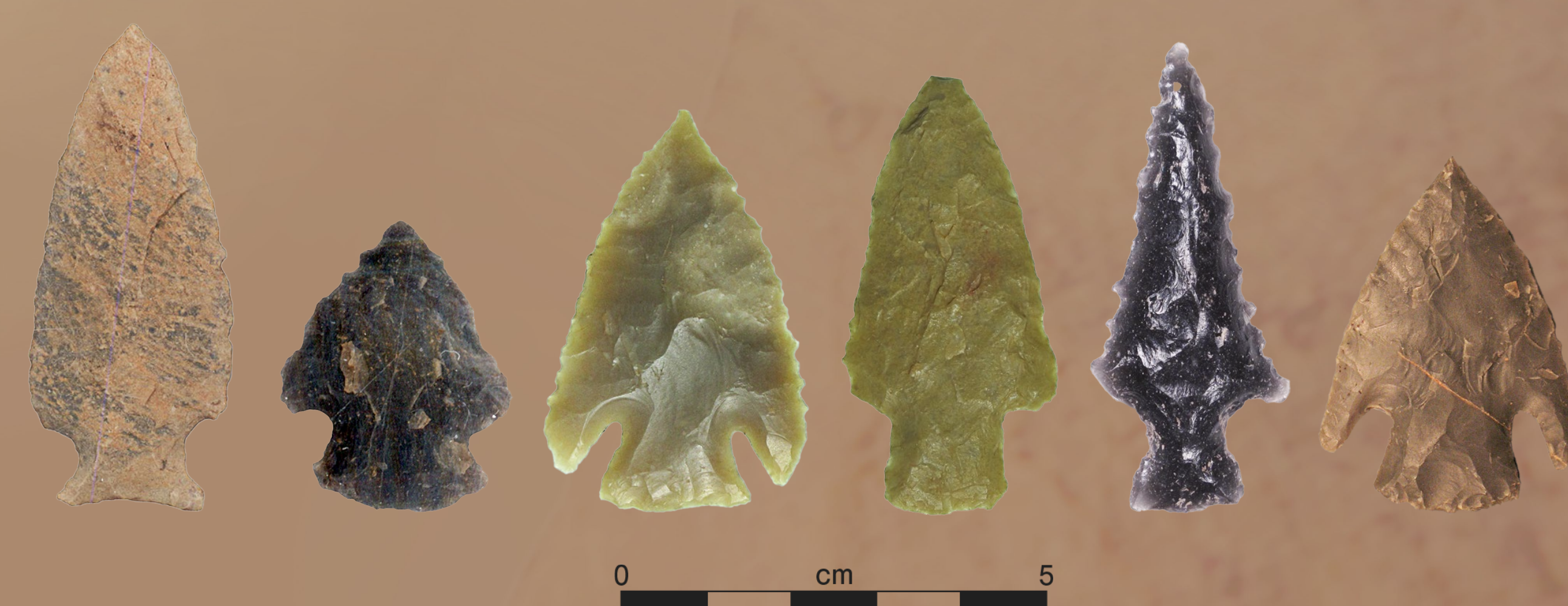
Middle to Late Archaic Period Transition: 2200–700 B.C.

Augustin, Pelona, Maljamar, Bipointed, Cortaro, Armijo, Datil, and Fresnal



Late Archaic Period North: 1500 B.C.–A.D. 300/500

Armijo Side-Notched, En Medio Side-Notched, Western Basketmaker II, and En Medio Corner-Notched



Late Archaic Period South: 1400 B.C.–A.D. 300/500

San Pedro Side-Notched, Carlsbad, Hueco Corner-Notched, Stemmed, Otero, and Shumla



Middle Archaic Period: 4,000/3500–1500 B.C.

San Jose, Split Stem, Northern Side-Notched, Sudden Side-Notched, San Rafael Side-Notched, Jarilla, and Chiricahua



Formative Period North: A.D. 300/500–1600

Trujillo Corner-Notched, Pueblo Stemmed, Pueblo Side-Notched, and Pueblo Triangular



Formative Period Southwest: A.D. 400/500–1600

Mimbres Corner-Notched, Diablo Corner-Notched, Temporal Side-Notched, Cosgrove Side-Notched, Swarts Side-Notched, Hinton Side-Notched, and Southwest Triangular



Formative Period Southeast: A.D. 300/500–1450

Livermore, Diablo, Means, Sacramento Serrated, Perdiz, Scallorn Corner-Notched, Washita Side-Notched, Harrell Side-Notched, and Fresno



Formative/Postcontact Period: A.D. 1300/1500–1860

Early Navajo, Cerro Rojo, Toyah, Garza, Coronado, and Indio-Hispano



Postcontact Period Metal: A.D. 1540–1900

A.D. 1500s, 1600s, 1700s–1800s, and post-1850
